COVID Outbreak

Dear residents, staff, and families,

We are sorry to report that we have a confirmed outbreak of COVID-19 at Evanston Summit. One resident tested positive for COVID earlier this week and has been in isolation since Monday. Another resident received a positive diagnosis today.

Public health has provided us with very thorough guidance. As a precautionary measure given the contagious nature of the Omicron variant, a COVID swab is being arranged for all residents. We will let you know once this has been scheduled.

Residents not in isolation may continue to enjoy meals in the dining room and scheduled recreational activities. Entertainment and interdenominational activities will be temporarily canceled given that the entertainers and religious leaders often visit more than one retirement residence.

Family and guests may continue to visit. You will be screened at the door by our concierge staff. For safety, you must:

- Be fully vaccinated
- Come to the centre prepared to present a vaccine QR code and photo identification and a QR code
- Not have been exposed to a known or suspected case of COVID 19
- Not have travelled outside of the country and been instructed to isolate
- Wear a mask continuously, including while in resident suites

Residents, please wear your masks in all common areas, except when eating. Monitor your symptoms daily. Should you feel unwell—even if only mildly—please contact the concierge immediately.
