Dear Martha's House families, residents, and staff,

We are pleased to let you know that the COVID outbreak at Martha's House has been lifted. We had 5 staff and 16 residents test positive for COVID during the outbreak. Those individuals are doing well and have made a full recovery.

We will continue to monitor everyone closely and all residents are reminded to report symptoms that may develop including but not limited to new or worsening cough, runny nose, nasal congestion, fever, unusual fatigue. Residents and staff who have not had a recent COVID booster or their annual influenza immunization are encouraged to do so.

We will return to our regular continental breakfast buffet on Saturday, November 5, 2022 and we will return to the use of linens in the dining room sometime this weekend. All activities will resume, as the schedule will permit.

Mandatory masking for staff and visitors has been rescinded, although anyone is welcome to wear a mask if they choose to do so.
