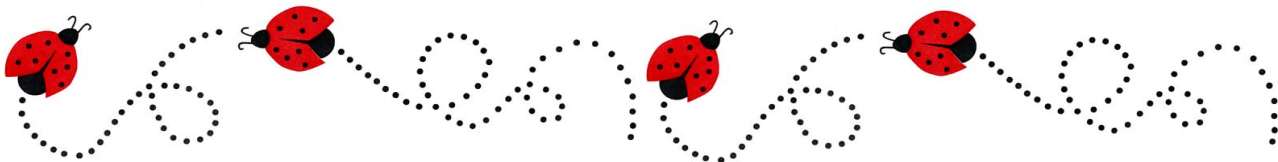
Security Reminder

We would like to remind everyone that when you leave your suite, to please make sure that you lock your door. Be aware of who you are letting into your suite. Anyone entering your suite should be wearing proper identification. You have the right to protect your home and question anyone entering your suite without the proper ID. If you see anything suspicious, please report it immediately to a staff member or call the Resident Attendant at 403-327-7531 or 403-715-2113.

Container Planting on the Patio

For any resident who wishes to have a container/pot of flowers on the patio for the summer, we need to set out guidelines for safety reasons. We understand that this brings a great deal of enjoyment and we wish to continue to see some green thumbs out there. Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- One pot/ container per resident. You must supply your own pot, soil and plants.
- Please put your name on your container. Staff can make a label for you.
- Pots / containers must be in good condition with a catch plate for any water overflow. (no stains on concrete)
- Pots / containers must be kept close to the building, on the cement within one foot of the dining room windows.
- You must be able to water and care for your own container.
- A watering can will be made available. This will be kept next to the rain barrel and must be returned there after watering. The rain barrel will be kept full at all times.
- Watering cans, extra soil, fertilizer, etc. may not be kept on the patio. Staff will remove these items if they are left on the patio.

Thank you to all of you that participated.

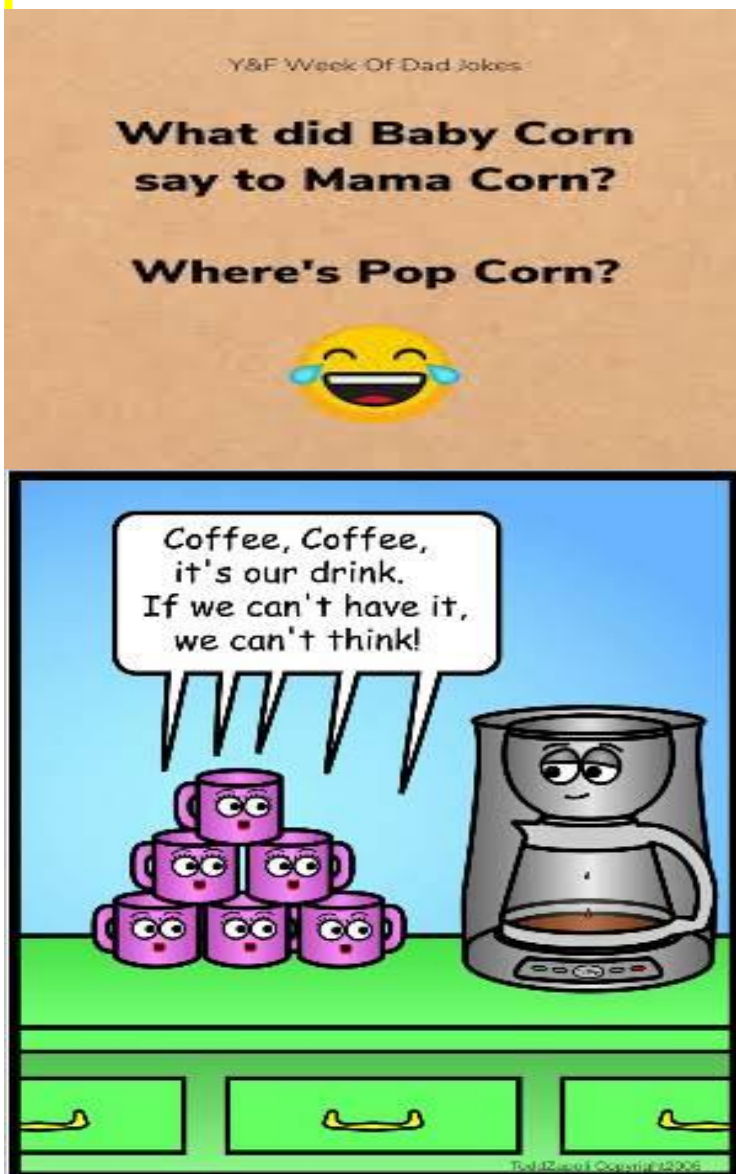
Words from the Book Nook!
