Nature's Favorite Sequence



Fibonacci Day, celebrated on November 23 (11/23), honors the famous number sequence: 1, 1, 2, 3where each number is the sum of the two be-

fore it. Discovered by Italian mathematician Leonardo of Pisa (Fibonacci) in the 1200s, this pattern appears in nature, from pinecones to galaxies. People mark the day with spiral-shaped treats or Fibonacci-inspired art. This November 23, celebrate the beauty of numbers—and maybe enjoy a croissant in a golden spiral!

Honouring Canadian Soldiers on Remembrance Day

Every November 11, Canadians pause to remember the brave men and who have 🖠 women served—and continue to serve—in the Canadian Armed Forces. From the



trenches of World War I to modern peacekeeping missions around the globe, their courage and sacrifice have shaped our nation's history and values.

More than 118.000 Canadians have lost their lives in military service, and countless others have returned home forever changed. Remembrance Day is a time to reflect on their legacy and express our deepest gratitude. Ceremonies across the country, including at the National War Memorial in Ottawa, bring communities together in solemn tribute.

This year, special recognition is being given to Sikh Canadian soldiers, whose contributions span over a century. Despite facing discrimination, these pioneers broke barriers to serve with honour. Canada Post has unveiled a commemorative stamp to celebrate their courage and dedication.

As we wear our poppies and observe a moment of silence at 11:00 AM. let us remember not only those who gave their lives, but also those who continue to serve today. Their commitment to peace, freedom, and unity remains a powerful example for all Canadians.

At Evanston Summit, we proudly join this national tradition with a moment of silence, poppy displays, and shared stories from residents and families.
